

Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters County of Bucks

2023 Municipal Primary, May 16, 2023

This is an official notice of a Municipal Primary to be conducted on May 16, 2023 in Bucks County. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at <https://www.fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fpca.pdf>. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your FPCA by fax to 215-348-6387, or by email to elections@buckscounty.org.

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB), available at <https://www.fvap.gov/uploads/FVAP/Forms/fwab.pdf>. Military electors may also use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **all** state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Referendum question write "yes" or "no."

JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT -- Vote for not more than Two -- All Precincts within Bucks County

JUDGE OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

JUDGE OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

COUNTY COMMISSIONER -- Vote for not more than Two -- All Precincts within Bucks County

REGISTER OF WILLS -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

COUNTY TREASURER -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

CLERK OF COURTS -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

CORONER -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Bucks County

- This ballot can be used to vote for federal offices.
- DO NOT write your name or any identifying number (SSN, driver's license) on this ballot.
- Photocopy this page if you require additional room for candidates or ballot initiatives.
- If you are voting in American Samoa, Guam, Puerto Rico, or the U.S. Virgin Islands, you may vote for Delegate or Resident Commissioner, and in presidential primaries. State laws vary about using the FWAB for other offices like Governor or Mayor. Learn more online at FVAP.gov.
