BUCKS COUNTY PARAMEDIC PROGRAM

The Bucks County Community College will offer a Paramedic Program at the Newtown Campus beginning in the fall of 2024.

An 18-month certificate program has been approved. We are also working on an option to include an associate degree after the certificate, though that is still in progress. The college is in the process of obtaining a CoAEMSP Accreditation for the certificate program.

Eligible EMTs/AEMTs who may be interested should apply directly to Bucks County Community College, select "Health Science – Paramedic" as the course major (free to apply), and schedule the placement tests (also free). This will help you determine if any prerequisite courses need to be taken. 3. Minimum of 18 years of age
4. Hold a high school diploma or equivalent
