Department of Community Economic Development (DCED)	Sewage Facilities Program (SFP)	Act 13 of 2012 establishes the Marcellus Legacy Fund and allocates funds to the Commonwealth Financing Authority (the "Authority") for statewide initiatives for complying with the Act of January 24, 1966 (1965 P. L. 1535, No. 537), known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act. The grant assists with costs associated with the planning work required under Act 537.
